



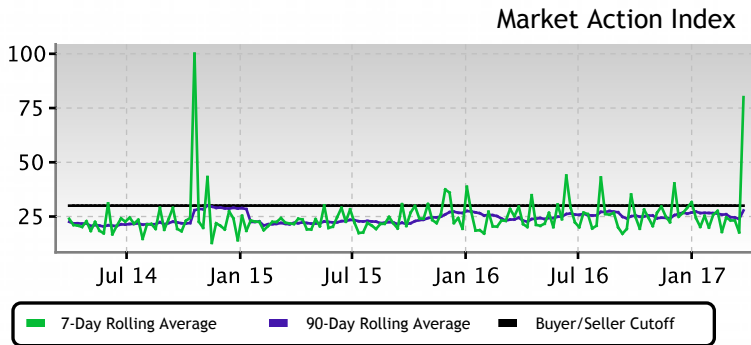
## This Week

The median list price in GLEN HEAD, NY 11545 this week is \$2,669,000.

Inventory has been lightening lately and the Market Action Index has been trending up. Though days-on-market is increasing, these are mildly positive indications for the market.

## Supply and Demand

- Home sales have been exceeding new inventory for several weeks. Since this is a Buyer's market, prices are not yet moving higher as excess inventory is consumed. However, as the supply and demand trends continue, the market moves into the Seller's zone, and we are likely to see upward pressure on pricing.



The Market Action Index answers the question "How's the Market?" by measuring the current rate of sale versus the amount of the inventory. Index above 30 implies Seller's Market conditions. Below 30, conditions favor the buyer.

Investigate the market in quartiles - where each quartile is 25% of homes ordered by price.
